Exhibitor/Sponsor Terms, Conditions and Rules

PHOTOGRAPHS

No photographs of exhibit spaces or merchandise shall be taken without the prior consent of IBMS or the exhibitor involved.

RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSE

Exhibitor assumes responsibility and agrees to indemnify and defend the IBMS and the facility and their respective employees and agents against any claim or expenses arising out of the use of the exhibition premises.

EXHIBIT PERSONNEL

(a) All participants affiliated with exhibits must be registered. Each person will be issued an exhibitor's badge and must be employed by the exhibitor or have a direct business affiliation. Complimentary Exhibit-Hall-Access-Only badges are limited to two per 3m x 3m booth and one attendee registration badge. Additional badges allowing access to Exhibit Hall are available for 50.00 USD each. For entrance to sessions, an attendee registration must be completed. (b) Please note that an exhibitor's badge will not admit an individual to IBMS's sessions. Individuals must register as delegates to attend sessions. A list of all exhibitor personnel must be returned to IBMS by the registration deadline.

ACCESSIBILITY FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

IBMS-selected venues will make every attempt possible to provide adequate accessibility for disable persons in public areas within their facility, such as sleeping rooms, function space, rest rooms, restaurants, etc. Subject to availability.

SUBLETTING OF EXHIBIT SPACE

Exhibitors are prohibited from assigning or subletting a booth or any of the space allotted to them. Exhibitors cannot exhibit or permit and merchandise or advertise materials in their space that are not part of their own regular products. It is not permitted for money to change hands (including credit card payments) for products, merchandise, membership, or services of any kind in the exhibit hall. Orders may be taken for payment at a later date.

VIOLATIONS

Each exhibitor, his/her agent, and employees agree to abide by the contract conditions/rules and regulations set forth herein, or any subsequent amendments or interpretations. Violation of any of these regulations on the part of the exhibitor, his/her employees or agents shall annul the right to occupy space and such exhibit will forfeit to IBMS all monies which may have been paid. Upon evidence of violations, IBMS may re-enter and take possession of the space occupied by the exhibitor, and may remove all personal items at the exhibitor's risk. The exhibitor shall pay all expenses and damages which IBMS may incur thereby. In addition, IBMS may refuse to permit the exhibitor to participate in future years.

CANCELLATIONS

In the event of cancellation of exhibits due to fire, strikes, government regulations, or other causes beyond IBMS control, IBMS shall not be held liable for failure to hold the IBMS Meeting as scheduled, and IBMS shall determine the amount of the exhibit fees to be refunded if any. Should any exhibitor or sponsor need to cancel, written notice of cancellation must be received by IBMS for consideration of refund. For notification of exhibit space cancellation received on or before January 1, 2010, refunds will be granted for 50% of the total amount of exhibit space contracted. At no time will refunds be granted for the cancellation of sponsorships.

INSURANCE

Exhibitors wishing to insure their exhibit materials, goods and/or wares of exhibits against theft, damage by fire, accident, or loss of any kind, must do so at their own expense. Each exhibiting company is responsible for obtaining insurance (liability and fire/theft) in such amounts as deemed appropriate to comply with its obligations hereunder and for its own protection. Security is in no case to be understood or interpreted by exhibitors as a guarantee to them against loss or theft of any kind.
